



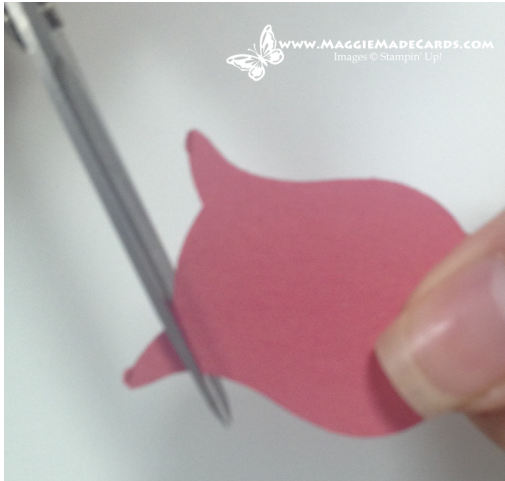

Step by Step Hello Kitty with Stampin' Up! Paper Punches

Items needed:

Word Window Punch, Owl Punch, 1" inch Circle Punch

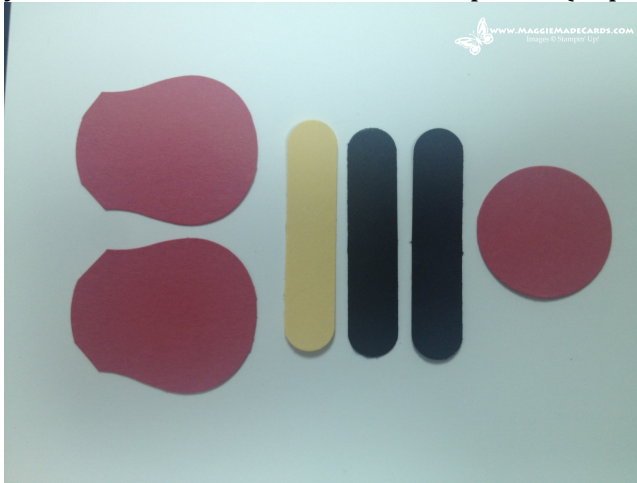
Step 1: Punch out two owls in pink or color of your choice. They will be used to make the bow. Cut off the ears.



Step 2: Cut the feet off on both owls.



Step 3: Continue punching out two window punches with black card stock and one yellow one, and one 1" inch Circle punch (in pink or color of your choice for bow).



Step 4: Re-insert yellow piece into Window punch as shown. It will be used as the nose.



Step 5: Re-insert both ends of one of the black pieces to make the eyes. Use a tweezer if you need to hold the shorter end. Make them both the same size.



Step 6: On the second black window punch snip off the rounded edges.



Step 7: Cut the strip in thirds. They will become the whiskers.



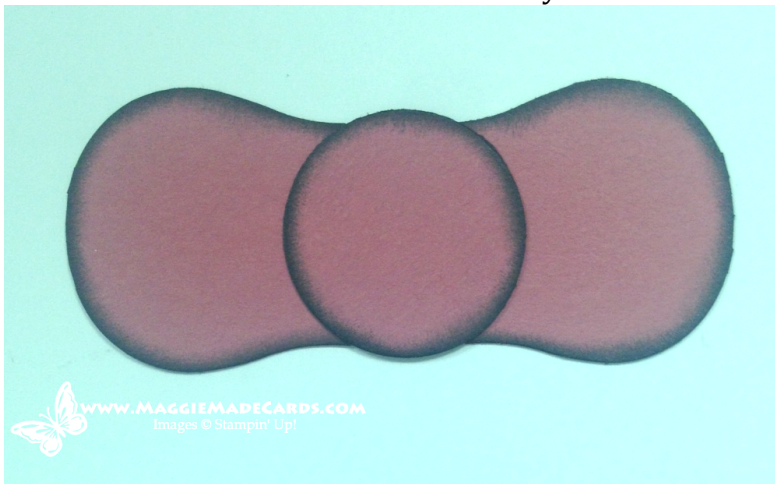
This is how they will look. Don't worry about how they look. They don't have to be perfect.



Step 9: Using Basic Black ink, daub the sides of the circle and the surgically cut owl all the way around all three pieces.



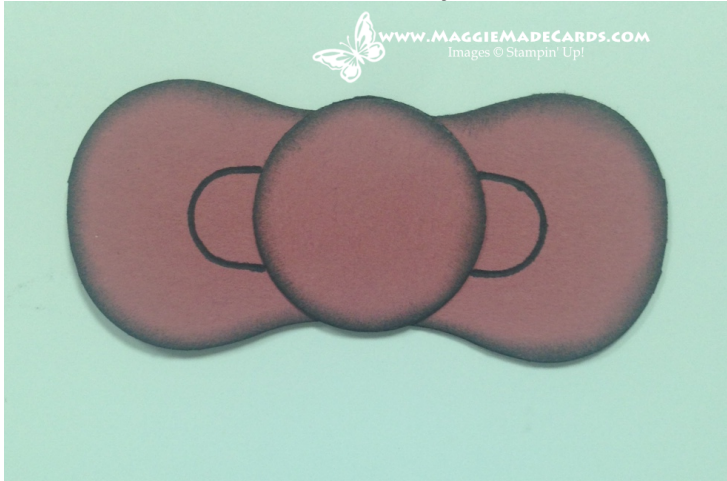
Step 10: Apply adhesive to put the bow together like this. You can apply rhinestones or other embellishments if you wish.



Step 11: Take the pieces to be used as the eyes and hold down to be used to trace the half circle around the circular part of the bow.



The bow will look like this after you draw the half circles.



Step 12: You're all done! All you have to do now is adhere the pieces to a whisper white card stock.
